TUTION FEE REFUND RULES

certified and agree as follows;

1. That the total money I paid to the LMC is £-----.
2. That the sum of £50 registration fee is non-refundable
3. The school fees paid is only refundable if I am turned down for visa on a reason that has to do with the school.
4. That if I cancel my course I must informed the college in writing 4 weeks before the course, otherwise no refund would be made: not even the deposit made towards the tuition fee.
5. Before I can claim a refund of fee paid for refusal of entry Visa, the college requires the student to supply the original letter of refusal from British Embassy/ High Commission (APP200), the appeal form (APP201) and other documents issued by the embassy, and those supplied to the prospective student by the college. If however, fees were refunded, the administration charge of £200 would be retained by the college.
6. In addition to the above, the college would not make refund of fees where student has used the college document (e.g. Registration or Enrolment Certificates) to procure extension of leave with the Immigration department. LMC is not part a part nor an extension of the British Immigration Department, therefore contract made with the College stands notwithstanding the refusal of extension of leave hence we are not under any obligation to make any refund, rather any fees owed must be paid.
7. No student is allowed to change course after the college has commenced teaching the intended course of the applicant for more than two *2) weeks. This is still subject to the College's discretion.
