Terms and Conditions for obtaining the Scholarship

1. You must apply for the scholarship at the same time when you are making application for your course.
2. You must come from a recognized developing country.
3. You must show that your total family income does not exceed £5000 in a year.
4. You must show that your entry qualification or GCSE includes at least one of the following subjects, Mathematics, Science, and English Language.
5. You must show a commitment that after your degree you will return to your home country and start work and contribute to your community.
6. The scholarship fund is limited; it will cover the cost of your tuition fees only. Therefore you still need to provide LMC with the evidence that you will be able to maintain yourself during the course of your study in the UK.
7. Where fraudulent statement and documentation has been used the scholarship committee have right to cancel the scholarship and such candidate may face prosecution.
8. You agree that on obtaining the scholarship your name will be published in your national newspaper with your photograph.
9. You must not be older than 25 years of age at the time of your application.
10. You must obtain a medical certificate that you are fit to study in the UK
11. You should have no relation to any member of the current scholarship committee.
12. The scholarship committee reserves the right to forego awarding any grant money in any or all of the categories if, in the committee's opinion, no applicant meets the minimum criteria necessary to be considered for an award
13. Decision is based on random sampling by an independent adjudicator.
